Ausgrid needs the information requested in this form so it can assess your requirements and make an appropriate response.

IMPORTANT:

You will need to complete all mandatory fields in order to be able to submit the form. Providing incorrect or incomplete information will result in an invalid application; this will mean that you will have to complete a new application and pay an additional submission fee.

This form is designed to be completed by a Qualified Electrical Professional. To provide some of the answers to these questions you will need to consult an electrical contractor or Accredited Service Provider (ASP)who may need to attend the site.

- Attach the DA Conditions if you selected DA Conditions of Consent in the 'Reason for this Application' in the previous step.
- From the drop down menu select if an Illumination Design is required.
- Select 'Yes' if a design is required and you will be providing the Illumination Design in the previous step you are required to upload the Design Documentation. (Go to Step 4).
- ii. Select 'No' if no Illumination design is required. (Go to Step 9).
- iii. Select 'The Public Lighting Customer wants Ausgrid to do the Illumination Design' if you want Ausgrid to provide an Illumination Design; Ausgrid will provide a quote for the design, and if acceptable Ausgrid will provide a short form contract to be signed by the Public Lighting Customer. The illumination design and construction design will be provided to Council with the F02 form for approval to proceed to construction under the Minor Capital Policy. (Go to Step 5).

- Select the Bracket Description from the drop down menu. If the bracket type is not available in the drop down list, select 'Other'. If other is selected you will need to specify Bracket Type.
