New cables in your area

Ausgrid is seeking input from the community as we plan a new cable route between Ausgrid's substation on Lloyd George Avenue, Burwood and Ismay Reserve, Homebush. The project will also see the decommissioning of our cable transition point at Columbia Lane, Homebush. We will continue to use our substation on Lloyd George Avenue, Burwood.

These facilities are connected by existing fluid-filled underground 132kV sub-transmission cables that run between the two sites. The cables are approximately 50

We are proposing to replace the existing cables with new 132kV underground cables and conduits (plastic pipes) bypassing the cable transition point in Columbia Lane. This project is part of a program to retire fluid-filled cables across our network.

Next Steps

Following the final community information session in September 2022, the project team will consider and incorporate the community feedback received where possible.

Ausgrid is committed to minimising the impact of this project on the community as much as possible and will keep residents informed of the final route and project progress through notifications and door knocks. Notice will also be given before any major work in the area starts.

Construction is planned to commence in early 2023. Residents will be informed once construction dates have been finalised.

Preferred cable route

We are proposing to install the new cables under the road between Homebush and Burwood. A map of the preferred route for the new cable is over the page.

Starting from Ismay Reserve, Homebush, the new cables will be installed in conduits (plastic pipes) to be constructed across Parramatta Road and under the railway line into Carrington Street, and then following Concord Rd, Sydney Street, Inverary Street and Lloyd George Avenue.

We will also be installing two new steel poles in the Public Reserve at 20 Parramatta Road and removing a small section of the overhead wires and associated poles.
